Top things to do with children

Studland Bay. Beautiful sandy beaches, right on your doorstep. One of the most natural and unspoilt beaches in Dorset

This internationally-acclaimed ape rescue centre, in 65 acres of beautiful Dorset woodland, is home to over 230 primates – including the largest group of chimps outside Africa. The park is imaginatively laid out and has food and drink outlets, picnic areas, a woodland walk, and a lot of monkey and ape antics to be enjoyed by visitors of all ages. Visitors can see the stars of TV's Monkey Life, then 'monkey around' in the south's largest Great Ape play area for children with its huge variety of swings, slides, and climbing frames. There is also a soft play area in the Treetops Cafe for young children. Open every day except Christmas Day.

Bournemouth Beach. Approximately seven miles of sandy beaches running from Christchurch in the east to Sandbanks in the west. Professional RNLI beach lifeguards and RLSS Volunteer Lifeguards operate during the season, with year-round RNLI cover at Boscombe Surf Reef.

Farmer Palmers Farm Park. An award visiting Farm Park for the under 8s. Open daily from February to December. www.farmerpalmers.co.uk

Poole Harbour and Brownsea Island. Take the ferry from Studland into Poole. From there you can catch a boat trip around the harbour, or take a boat to Brownsea Island, where there are woodland walks, children's adventure trails and children's wildlife tracker packs.

Lulworth Castle. A great castle with lots to see. Bring a picnic as there is no cafe, or take a walk to The Weld Arms just outside the Castle for some great pub food. The Castle is closed on Saturdays. Opening dates and times may vary throughout the year, so please check the website or call 0845 450 1054 before visiting.

Corfe Castle. For a very different castle visit Corfe Castle, a romantic ruin dating from the time of William the Conqueror. Let your children's imaginations run wild while they explore the ruins - and there are events throughout the year. At the foot of the castle, The Tea Rooms is a good spot for a break, with a summer garden and winter log fires. www.nationaltrust.org.uk/corfe-castle/

Swanage Railway. Stations at Norden, Corfe Castle and Swanage. Swanage Railway runs steam and diesel trains from Norden and Corfe Castle into Swanage and back. Norden park and ride offers the simplest parking option. Tel: 01929 475207, www.swanagerailway.co.uk.

Bovington Tank Museum. The Tank Museum houses the world's broadest and best collection of tanks. Follow the Tank Story, take a look at almost 150 tanks in the Discovery Centre, check out Tank Displays (see the museum's events calendar for dates and times).

Kimmeridge Bay .An acclaimed nature reserve and part of the Jurassic Coast .Although there are no sandy beaches, the sheltered bay is good for swimming, diving, surfing and windsurfing. Large ledges act as natural jetties for wandering along to explore marine wildlife. It is one of the best places in the country to go rock pooling. Dorset Wildlife Trust runs a marine centre which is open every day in summer.Tel : 01929 481044.
