From M25 junction 18, turn left towards Chorleywood.

Follow this road for approximately 3 miles, going straight over the crossroads to Latimer.

Just after entering the 30mph zone on the brow of the hill, you will see the house on your right.

Turn into the drive, over the bridge and right through the gateway after the white house.

You will enter the main drive and the house is the big cream one in front of you.
