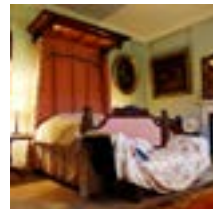

Directions

The Broughton Hall Estate is on the main A59, only 2.5 miles west of Skipton, with easy access to the motorway network.

When travelling from Skipton, the slip road down to Broughton Hall is on the left hand side, 200 metres past The Bull Inn.

When travelling from Lancashire, Broughton Hall is on the right hand side, 2.5 miles before Skipton. Watch for the signs 200 metres before The Bull Inn.

Trains run frequently from Skipton station to all parts of the UK and the Leeds Bradford, Manchester and Liverpool airports are readily accessible by road.

Top places to visit & shop nearby

Skipton

Skipton is a pretty market town, just ten minutes away from Broughton Hall, most notable for its colourful markets and its formidable medieval castle. The narrowboat cruises running along the Leeds Liverpool Canal are a very popular way to see the town, for good reason, and Skipton has developed a reputation for its range of specialist shops and restaurants. The town hall houses a museum of local history and hosts regular craft fairs, which are well worth a look.

Skipton holds a market four days a week: every Monday, Wednesday, Friday and Saturday. On summer market days, stalls line the High street and Skipton is bright and bustling with visitors.

Yorkshire Dales National Park

Broughton Hall is a great base from which to explore the expansive Yorkshire Dales National Park. With their outstanding scenery, wide range of wildlife and rich heritage, the Dales offer some of the best walks in the UK.

Grassington

A beautiful village in the Yorkshire Dales, full of old stone buildings and traditional shops. The small community is renowned for their commitment to local history, with the volunteer-run Grassington Folk Museum being one of the best in the area. In December, the villagers hold their annual Dickensian Festival, dressing up in Victorian costume for an old-fashioned Christmas market, with shoe-shine boys, chestnut-sellers, and street performers evoking a bygone age.

Ilkley

The spa town of Ilkley is a popular tourist destination, well known for its Victorian architecture and beautiful floral displays. Great for shopping, it supports a wide range of little independent businesses, including some great delicatessens, vintage fashion boutiques, bookshops and crafts specialists. Most notably, it is home to Lishman's of Ilkley, an award-winning butcher shop, as well as the Michelin-starred Box Tree restaurant and Betty's, an elegant bakery and tearoom. Ilkley Moor is well worth exploring for the prehistoric rock carvings found along its winding footpaths.
