## **Directions to Ewelme Manor**

From Cirencester take the A433 west to Tetbury. In Tetbury where the road bends to the left, turn right signposted Kingscote on the A4135. Cross over the crossroads at the Calcot Manor traffic lights. Follow this road for approximately 3 miles and take a right turn on a small road signposted Uley. Go straight over the next crossroads and follow the road to the bottom of the hill and the village of Uley. At the junction, turn left and follow the road for approximately 1.3 miles. The entrance to Ferney Hill will be found on the right hand side through a five bar gate marked 'Private' opposite Parsons Close. Follow the stone driveway past the fields and up to the house.

If coming from the M4 we normally turn off at the Malmesbury junction (junction 17) and follow the road past Malmesbury to Tetbury. You then turn left, instead of right on the large bend at the end of Tetbury high street onto the Kingscote road A4135 and continue with the directions.
