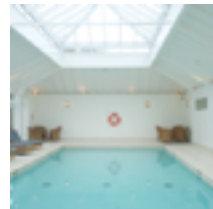

From the North

From the M40 (southbound): take the exit at junction 15. You'll want to take the A429 to Cirencester. After 20 miles traveling down the A429, you'll arrive in Morteton-in-Marsh. Once you're on the High Street in Moreton, take the 1st exit on the mini roundabout onto the A44/Oxford St. Oxford St will become London Rd. Travel down the A44 for 5 miles until you reach a turning for Stow, on the A436. Go down the A436 for 1 mile, and on your 2nd left turn onto Church St and travel into Kingham, keeping a slight left to go onto Station Road/the B4450. Take a right after around 1 mile, then take the 2nd right. Continue down this lane, go across the railway bridge and you'll be in a small. Look out for a plaque on your right which says 'Bruen Stable Cottages', where Newmarket House is waiting for you!

From the South/West

From the M5 (northbound): take the exit at junction 11A. You'll want to be going down the A436. Stay on this road and after about 12 miles. After traveling down the A436 you'll reach a junction. Turn right onto the A40 and travel down this road for about 6 miles. At the roundabout, take the 1st exit onto the A429 and travel down this road for around 7 miles. After about seven miles you'll want to take a right to go on the A424 towards Burford. Take this road, and drive for 6 miles until you reach a sign on the left that will say 'Bruen: 2.5 miles'. Take this road, and after about 0.5 miles you'll need to take a right, and then after about 100ft a left. Continue down this road for about 2 miles and take a left at the plaque where it says 'Bruern Stable Cottages'. You have arrived!

From the East

From the M40 (northbound): take the exit at junction 8 onto the A40 that goes towards Oxford or Cheltenham. Continue on the A40 for about 24 miles, and then you need to be taking the exit towards Burford. When you get to the roundabout, take the 4th exit onto the A361 that will take you through Burford. After about a mile on the A361 take a left towards Stow on the A424 then hang a right to continue going to Stow. After about 1 mile take a right exit towards Milton-under-Wychwood, that's 3 miles away. Go through the small village of Milton, and when you reach the junction take a left onto Church Rd. Continue on Church Rd and it will blend into Bruen Rd, which will, after 1.5 miles will get you to the cottage. Look out for the plaque that says 'Bruen Stable Cottages', where Newmarket House will be waiting for you!

As we're sure you're well aware, the Cotswolds is a foodie's paradise: literally everything and anything is grown and raised on these vast, green expanses. The buying and selling of organic foods has long been a tradition within these villages, and the successes of the Cotswolds farmers markets has now led to a national trend in 'localised ethical shopping', a movement spearheaded by the Prince of Wales, who has his own market shop in Tetbury, and firmly believes strong local markets creates a strong local economy and a vibrant society.

Top things to do with children

Our top recommendations for outings with children are below.

Bourton-on-the-Water

About 9 miles/20 minute drive away, the picturesque village of Bourton-on-the-Water is an outstanding place of natural beauty. Pretty houses flank the river Windrush, which winds its way through the centre, and is shallow enough for your children to splash around in. Although a village, there is plenty to see and do, so you can be sure that everyone will be kept busy. Attractions include a model village (www.themodelvillage.com), the Cotswold Birdland Park (www.birdland.co.uk), The Dragonfly Maze (next to the Birdland Park) and the Cotswold Motor Museum.

Around 16 miles away/30 minute drive lies the beautiful grounds of Blenheim Palace, where you can lose yourself in the estate's vast and beautiful park gardens. As well as discovering all the interesting things inside palace, outside there is also an adventure playground, a maze, a butterfly farm and a miniature train. Check for limited opening hours in the winter months. In Woodstock there are lots of shops to explore and there is the local Oxfordshire museum on the high street – worth a quick visit to enjoy a coffee and cake in the airy glass-fronted café.

Top places to visit and shop nearby

Moreton-in-Marsh

11.6 miles away/22 minute drive

A wonderful market town that offers lots to do in the way of quality food and drink. Be sure to check out Warner's Budgens on the High Street and The Cotswold Cheese Shop, voted as Britain's best New Deli, which sell a wide range of breads and delicatessen food. On Tuesdays there is a wonderful market that sells local produce and other artisan crafts, and, if you're here in September, don't miss the Moreton Show, a one-day countryside event that attracts around 20,000 visitors - check their website to find out more: www.moretonshow.co.uk. Also, find the time to have a drink at The Bell Inn, where many locals believe it to be the inspiration behind The Prancing Pony, the famous pub in J R R Tolkien's Lord of the Rings books.

Stow-on-the-Wold

Another of the Cotswolds famous market towns, Stow has been one since the 12th century. There are many good restaurants, pubs and cafés to visit. Stow is also an important centre for fine antiques shops, art galleries and craft shops. A superb farmers' market is held in the town's square on the second Thursday of each month, between 9am-1pm.
