Cirencester

Cirencester is a pretty market town in the east of Gloucestershire and is often referred to as the capital of the Cotswolds, Cirencester's market own status, goes all the way back to the Domesday book and markets still operate every Monday and Friday. Farmers markets, craft stalls and antiques are the most popular attractions.

Around town, there's The Corinium museum dedicated to Cirencester's Roman heritage, and Chedworth Roman Villa is one of the largest remaining Roman Villa in Britain.

If a large dose of retail therapy is what you need, however, then Cirencester has a number of independent shops and a good array of high-street stores.

Moreton-in-Marsh

A beautiful scenic route straight through the heart of the Cotswolds will take you Moreton, a wonderful market town that offers lots to do in the way of quality food and drink. Be sure to check out Warner's Budgens on the High Street and The Cotswold Cheese Company (5 High Street), voted as Britain's best New Deli, which sell a wide range of breads and delicatessen food. On Tuesdays there is a wonderful market that sells local produce and other artisan crafts, and, if you're here in September, don't miss the Moreton Show, a one-day countryside event that attracts around 20,000 visitors - check their website to find out more: www.moretonshow.co.uk. Also, find the time to have a drink at The Bell Inn (High Street), where many locals believe it to be the inspiration behind The Prancing Pony, the famous pub in J R R Tolkien's Lord of the Rings books.

Stow-on-the-Wold

Another of the Cotswolds famous market towns, Stow has been one since the 12th century. There are many good restaurants, pubs and cafés to visit. Stow is also an important centre for fine antiques shops, art galleries and craft shops. A superb farmers' market is held in the town's square on the second Thursday of each month, between 9am-1pm.
